From the Driver's Seat

If you attended the April dinner meeting, you know the club has a new Sponsor. Chapman Chevrolet has committed to being the new sponsor of the Scottsdale Corvette Club.

Chapman Chevrolet is part of the Chapman Automotive Group that has been in the valley since 1966 and is still family-owned. The Chapman Automotive Group consists of 25 locations and 18 brands throughout Phoenix, Tucson, Payson, Yuma and Las Vegas. I would like to thank Chase Gibbs, General Manager, and Syed Rizvi, Fleet Director, for their support of the Club. If you are looking for a new Corvette, maybe get on the list for a new Grand Sport. Please contact Syed or Chase. Chapman also has a modern service department.

I have had my car serviced there as have a number of other members. Their location is an easy drive south on the 101 to the 60 to McClintock south a few blocks to the dealership on the corner of Baseline and McClintock in Tempe. For service you can contact Brianna Bourlier, 480-752-1465, or at her email, BriannaBourlier@chapmanchoice.com. Let them know you are from the Scottsdale Corvette Club and thank them for their sponsorship. If you want to wait for your vehicle, they have a clean waiting room and there are a few restaurants nearby. Also check with them; I believe they will give a free Lyft ride within 25 miles of the dealership.

I would like to give a special thanks to Juan Urrea for helping to secure the sponsorship from Chapman as it was his contact, Syed, who got us in the door. Also want to thank Kirsten Avgenackis, who went with Juan and myself to meet Chapman and pitch the sponsorship.

Now for the other item I have been dealing with so far this year, the monthly dinner meetings. When I joined the club in 2022 our monthly meetings were at Ancala Country Club, we paid \$40 for the buffet dinner and a cash bar. The food at first was pretty good, but in 2023 it started to go downhill both in quality and quantity and bar prices increased. I had several meetings with them with a lot of promises but no improvement. In 2024 we moved to Venue 8600. Again, we had a buffet (quality and quantity improved), bar prices were reasonable, nice room and plenty of parking. We raised the price to \$45. In 2025 they changed the vendor for the bar, so we had a few minor issues.

For both of these venues, there are either minimums or room charges besides the actual food cost. The club used funds from Van's sponsorship to subsidize the cost. With Van's going away in 2025 we were faced with either raising the price to \$50+ or finding a new location.

In January, we had a meeting at Rudy's Bar-B-Q using their back room, which they did not charge us for. We had a good turnout of 55+, but as we found, the space was tight and there wasn't room to move easily to socialize with other members, which is one of the main reasons for the meeting. In February, we tried to go back to Venue 8600, we had a good speaker lined up, we raised the price to \$50 and we only had 18 to 20 people sign up. With the room and other charges, the club would lose close to \$1,000 with the low turnout, so the board decided to cancel the meeting, forfeiting our deposit of \$480, cutting our losses.

In March and April, we had our meeting at Rudy's again. The number of participants has gone down each month. Even with a

smaller group it is still not conducive to the main reason for our meetings, socializing with other members.

That brings us to May and beyond. For May, we are going to CPK (California Pizza Kitchen) on Scottsdale Road, just south of Shea. The reason the board selected CPK is twofold: First the private room is set up so we will have more room to walk around and socialize with other members. Second, there is no minimum or room charge and they will do separate checks.

On a side note, for those long-term members, this is close to the location where the club first began at Sam's Café. We will continue to look for a location that fits our needs as a club, if you have any ideas, please let us know. I would like to thank Sue Henry for doing legwork on a new location, she came up with CPK. Now I need a good place for the Holiday Party, any ideas, let me know.

As you know, May is our last dinner meeting until September. Sami and his activity group are working on day trips and small dinners for us who are here throughout the summer. If you have an idea for a day trip, or a restaurant, let Sami know and he and his committee can get it put together.

For those members leaving us for other parts of the country for the summer, safe travels. For those traveling over the summer be sure to bring back good stories and pictures to share at the September meeting.

Happy Birthday to members celebrating their birthdays in May and June.

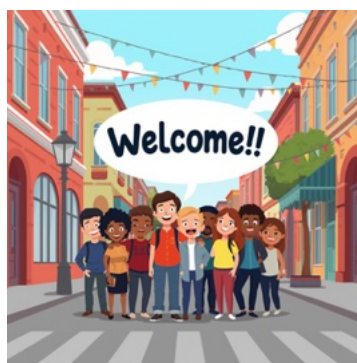
To those who do attend regularly—congratulations. You're making the most of your club, building friendships, and enjoying your Corvette in ways you might not have expected.

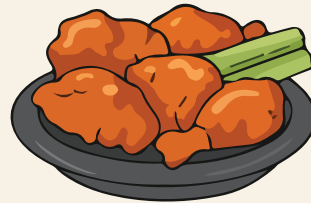

Mardi Gras Party March 28, 2026

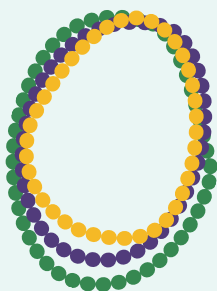

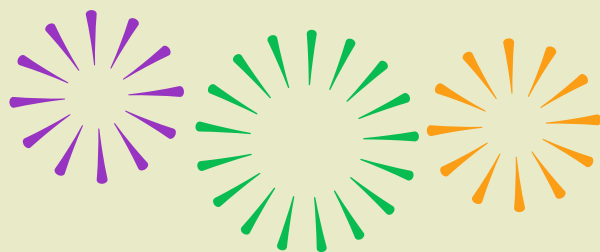

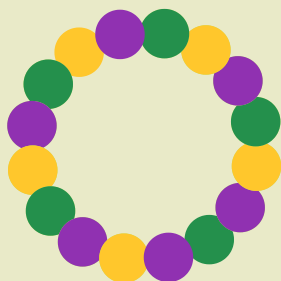

Phoenix Beer Company April 14, 2026

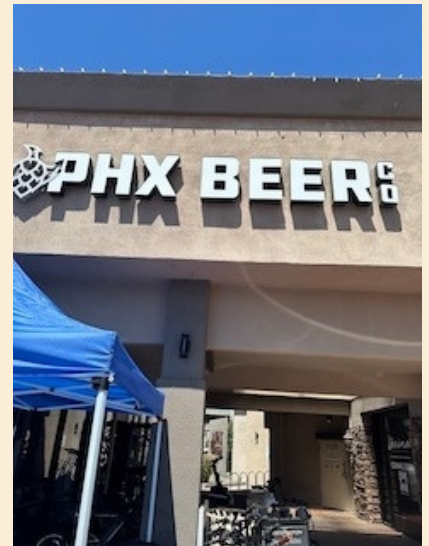

IMPORTANT CLUB RADIO INFORMATION



For any members who do not yet own a club radio, are looking to replace the one they have, or would like to add an earpiece, our supplier **HQ98** in south Scottsdale can assist you. HQ98 offers both a Bantam and a Motorola model. The Bantam has a decent range and performs admirably. At the time of writing, it was roughly \$75 less expensive than the Motorola. The Motorola has a larger battery and therefore offers increased range... hence the higher price.

When caravanning on a club drive, members need to maintain a safe distance behind the car in front of them. However, this distance should not extend into large gaps. If even a couple of cars leave too much space, the vehicles at the back may not hear radio transmissions. That said, neither radio is recommended over the other—the choice is yours.

Regarding earpieces: If you've participated in a club drive, you know it can be difficult to reach for your radio to respond. And if you're driving with the top down, hearing transmissions can be even harder. HQ98 offers several earpieces that help with this. If you decide to purchase one, please tell HQ98 the exact radio model you own so they can provide the correct connector.

Lastly, you do not need to purchase your radio from HQ98. However, please note that **the Scottsdale Corvette Club uses its own frequency. If you buy a radio elsewhere, you will need to bring it to HQ98 to have the club frequency configured, and there is a charge for this service.**

We always say, "We just want to have fun." Being able to hear directions, comments, and the occasional bad joke through your radio makes participating in a drive both safer and a little more fun.
